To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harry C. Zaun, a citizen of the United States, residing at Atlantic Beach, Nassau County, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric Glow Lamp, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 of the drawing is a front elevational

view of an electric glow lamp embodying my new design, and including two illuminable elements of substantially identical appearance.

Fig. 2 of the drawing is a side elevational view thereof, showing the two elements placed back to back.




