## DESIGN FOR A BULB FOR INCANDESCENT LAMPS.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 25,572, dated June 2, 1896.

Application filed March 13, 1896. Serial No. 583,131. Term of patent 31 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ELMER W. GHLIMER, of Warren, in the county of Trumbull and State of Ohio, have invented and produced a 5 certain new and original Design for a Bulb for Incandescent Lamps; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it apo pertains to make and use the same.

This is a design for bulbs for incandescent lamps.

In the accompanying drawing the figure is a view in perspective.

The leading or characteristic feature of my design consists of a cone or turnip-like body

A. This body tapers from its upper contracted end a outwardly to its lower widened end a', which latter is exteriorly convexed. That portion of body A above the line b is of 20 ground or colored glass, while the lower end a' beneath said line is of clear glass.

I claim-

The design for a bulb for incandescent lamps herein shown and described.
