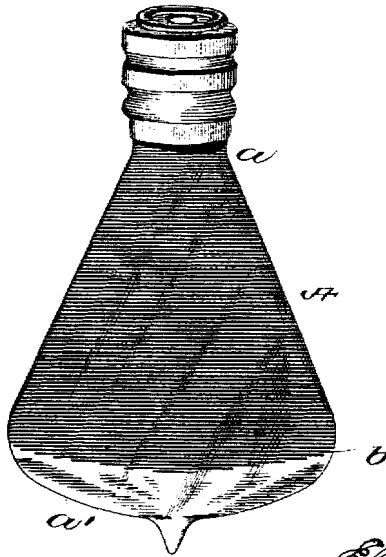

## DESIGN FOR A BULB FOR INCANDESCENT LAMPS.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 25,572, dated June 2, 1896.

Application filed March 13, 1896. Serial No. 583,131. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ELMER W. GILLMER, of Warren, in the county of Trumbull and State of Ohio, have invented and produced a certain new and original Design for a Bulb for Incandescent Lamps; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same.

This is a design for bulbs for incandescent lamps.

In the accompanying drawing the figure is a view in perspective.

The leading or characteristic feature of my design consists of a cone or turnip-like body

A. This body tapers from its upper contracted end *a* outwardly to its lower widened end *a'*, which latter is exteriorly convexed. That portion of body A above the line *b* is of ground or colored glass, while the lower end *a'* beneath said line is of clear glass.

I claim—

The design for a bulb for incandescent lamps herein shown and described.
