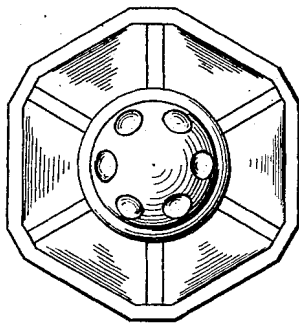
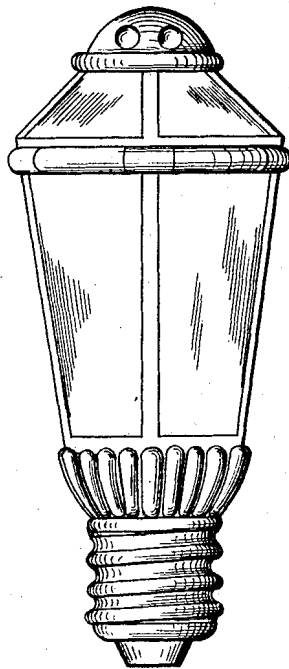

DESIGN FOR A LANTERN.

Application filed June 11, 1927. Serial No. 22,394. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED WEBER, a citizen of the Republic of Austria, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lanterns, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
