



DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC BULB.

Application filed November 8, 1927. Serial No. 24,037. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY D. KADEL, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Brooklyn, New York, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Electric Bulbs, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the ac-companying drawing, forming part thereof.
