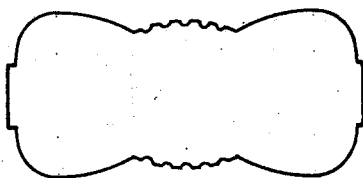
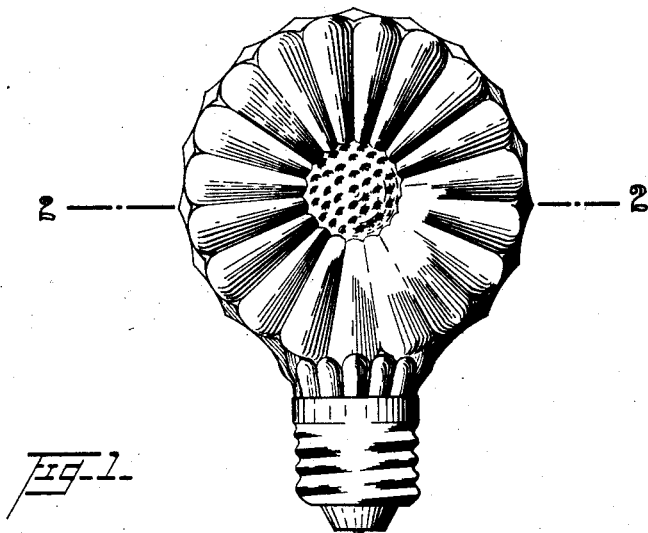

HENRY D. KADEL, OF BROOKLYN, NEW YORK.

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC BULB.

Application filed November 8, 1927. Serial No. 24,037. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HENRY D. KADEL, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Brooklyn, New York, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Electric Bulbs, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

the contour of a sectional top view of an electric bulb, showing my new design.
