

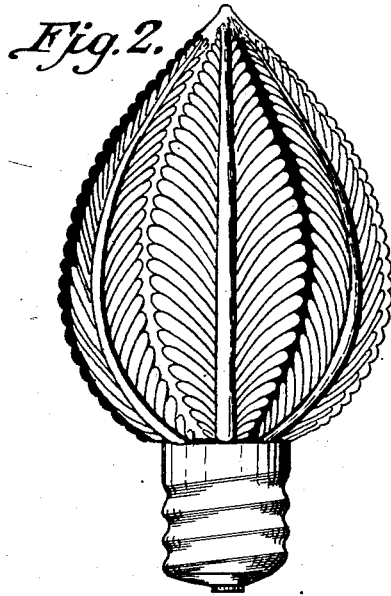
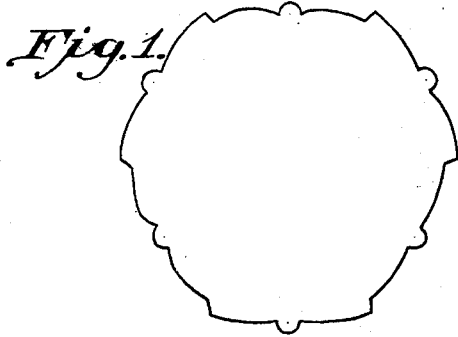

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC BULB.

Application filed October 3, 1927. Serial No. 23,605. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY D. KADEL, citizen of the United States, and resident of Brooklyn, New York, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Electric Bulbs, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a diagrammatic outline of the top view of my new design.

Figure 2 is the front elevation of an electric bulb, showing my new design.
