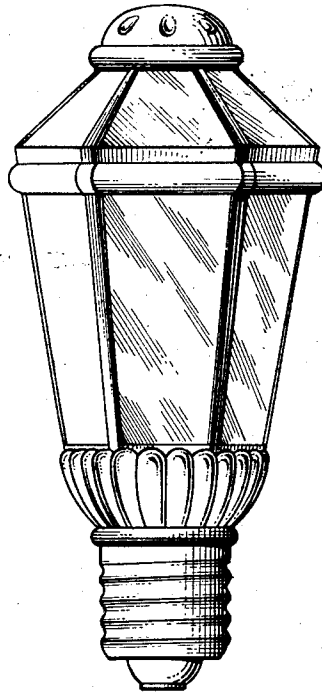
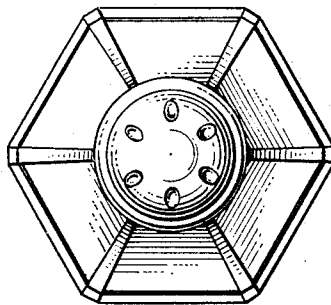

DESIGN FOR A LANTERN.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ABRAHAM L. BUSCHMAN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Forest Hills, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lanterns, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
