

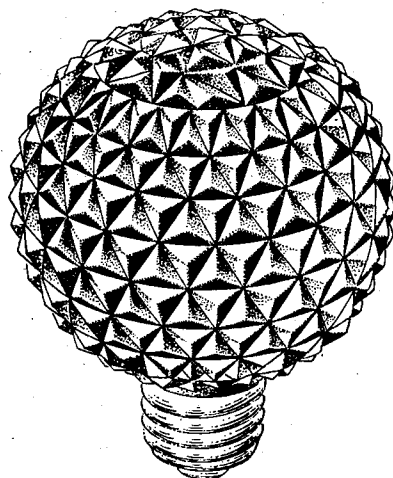

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC BULB OR THE LIKE

Application filed February 28, 1931. Serial No. 38,877. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ABRAHAM L. BUSCHMAN, a citizen of the United States, and resident of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Electric Bulb or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which the figure is a perspective view of an electric bulb embodying my new design.

The dominant feature of the invention re-

sides in the pyramidal configurations arranged in adjacent annular rows, any successive three pyramidal configurations in one row forming with its complementary set of configurations in an adjacent row a hexagonal cluster of pyramidal configurations.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an electric bulb or the like substantially as shown and described.
