

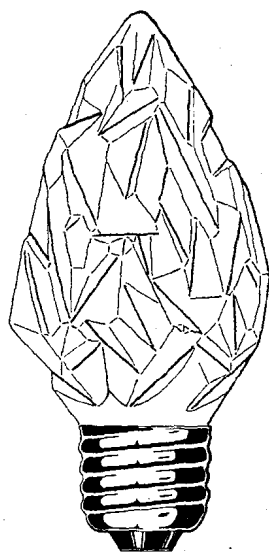

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC LAMP

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, KENNETH R. HALEY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Beaver Falls, in the county of Beaver, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric Lamp, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Referring to the drawing, the figure is

an elevation of an electric lamp comprising my invention.

The bulb portion of the lamp is of clear, translucent or colored glass.
